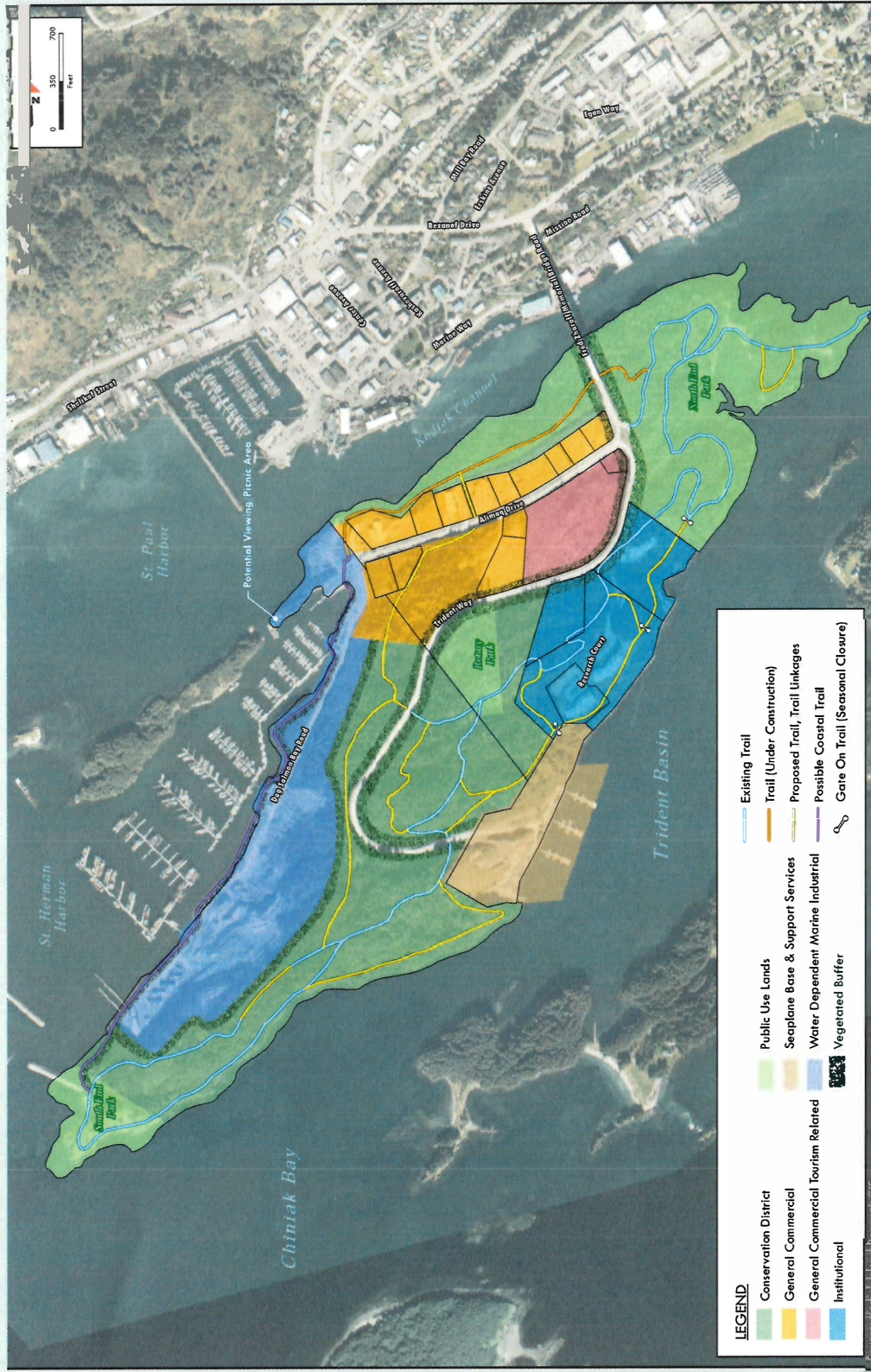














FIGURE 8: Concept A - Minimized Development
