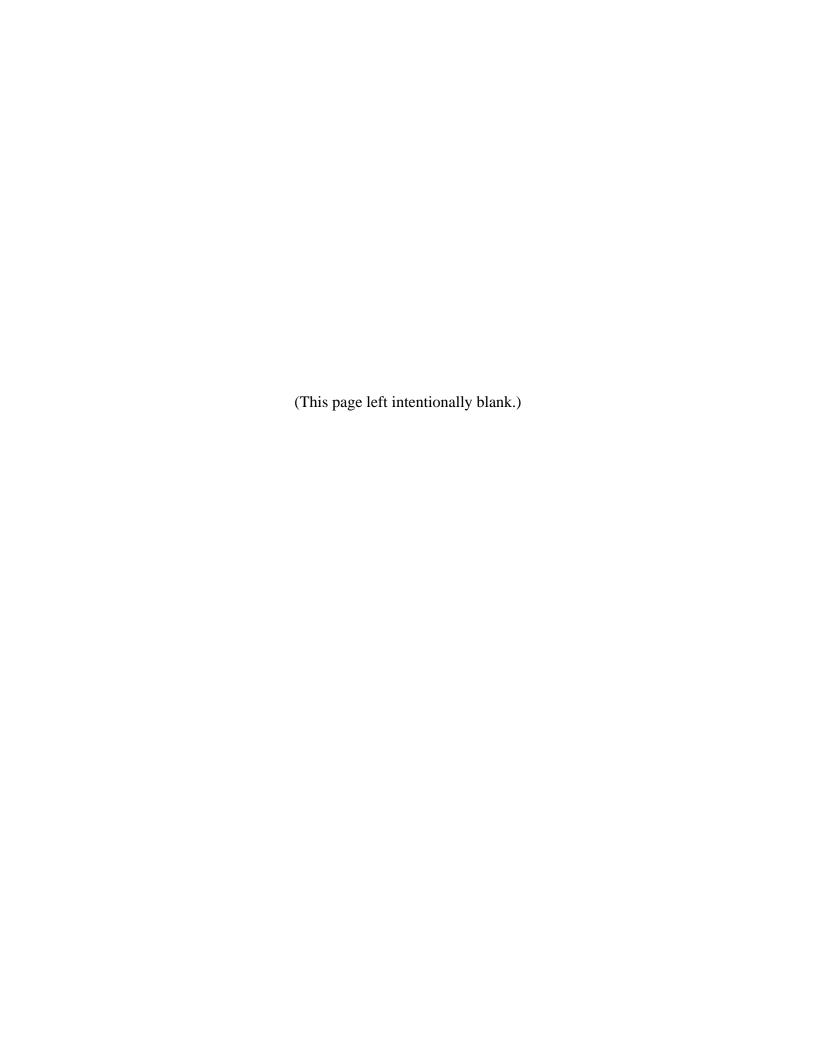
## CITY COUNCIL – BOROUGH ASSEMBLY JOINT WORK SESSION AGENDA
