- Passed in the First Reading, Ordinance No. 1380, Amending Kodiak City Code Chapter 2.12, Relating to the Fire Department Employee Residency Requirement

- Awarded the bid for FY2019 Sodium Chloride to Spenard Builders Supply, dba Polar Supply in the amount of \$98,440 with funds coming from the FY2019 Public Works Department, Street Supply account
