At the December 8, 2016, Regular Council Meeting, the City Council took the following action:

Adopted Resolution No. 2016–42(SUB), Adopting a FY2018 State Capital Improvement Program List

Adopted Resolution No. 2016–43, Reallocating Funds Between General Fund Departments to Support the Addition of a Human Resource Manager and a Human Resource Specialist in the Executive Administration Department

Authorized bid award to demolish the Old Library building with B & R Fish By Products Inc. in the amount of \$263,245, with funds coming from the Building Improvement Fund, Demolition of the Old Library building as part of the New Fire Station Project, Project No. 6015/15-06 and authorized the City Manager to execute the documents on behalf of the City

Authorized the purchase of the D4L Centrifuge from Andritz Separation Inc. in the amount of \$390,400, with funds coming from the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund, WWTP Centrifuge Project No. 7519/17-03

Authorized the purchase and shipment of the interpretive panels in an amount not-to-exceed \$18,000 with funds coming from the General Capital Project Fund, Downtown Revitalization Project, Project No. 4039

Elected Randy Bishop as Deputy Mayor for a one-year term
