Please be notified that, effective immediately, the following will be in effect until further notice:

All Kodiak Island Businesses and Activities, including all retail and service types, indoor recreational activities, bars, restaurants, religious gatherings, grocery and any business or service that is open to the public may operate at **100% customer capacity, with the ability to social distance**. Capacity is calculated from the business fire marshal occupancy load.

Each business and facility is encouraged to use COVID-19 mitigation measures and whenever reasonable to use online shopping, appointment shopping, and/or curbside service (takeout orders).

The COVID-19 virus is highly contagious and is still present in our community; please continue to take appropriate precautions to keep yourself and our community healthy.

- Wash your hands frequently.
- Wear a mask when in public; masks are strongly recommended.
- Stay home and away from others if you are not feeling well.
- Limit social gatherings and maintain six feet of distance between yourself and others who are not in your household.
