### **KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: November 19, 2020**

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has been notified of positive test results for COVID-19 associated with the Kodiak Island Borough.

**Nine (9) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough. All cases are classified as community spread.**

This brings the case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough to two hundred and one (201); fifty-one (51) cases are currently classified as active. Three individuals have completed their isolation period and have been removed from active status.

**Wear a mask when in public!**

**Stay home if you are not feeling well!**

**When planning travel, please also plan for a few days off at home and testing before returning to normal activities in case you have carried the virus with you.**

**Limit social gatherings and maintain six feet of distance between yourself and others who are not in your household.**

If you are not sick, please continue to take precautionary measures to stay healthy:

- Wear as mask/face covering when out in public
- Keep your social circles small and gatherings limited.
- Maintain social distancing (six feet of distancing between you and others) who are not in your household.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after using the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, or cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces and objects daily (e.g., tables, countertops, light switches, doorknobs, and cabinet handles) using a regular household detergent and water.
