KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: December 10, 2020

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has been notified of new positive COVID-19 test results within the Kodiak Island Borough.

Forty-eight (48) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.

- Two (2) new cases were tested on 12/4/20
 - Two (2) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
- Eighteen (18) new cases were tested on 12/8/20
 - o Ten (10) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
 - Eight (8) cases are considered community transmission
- Twenty-eight (28) new cases were tested on 12/9/20
 - Nineteen (19) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
 - Five (5) cases are considered community transmission
 - Four (4) cases are non-residents whose transmission of the virus is unknown

This brings the case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough to six hundred and forty-six (646); three hundred and eight (308) cases are classified as active locally.

To date, there have been a total number of twenty-one (21) local hospitalizations and two (2) deaths associated with COVID-19; four (4) patients are currently hospitalized in Kodiak, and one individual was transported off island yesterday for a higher level of care.

DHSS is urging anyone who receives a positive test result to <u>notify their own close contacts</u> as soon as possible so individuals can quarantine without delay.

The COVID-19 virus is spreading quickly in our community, please take appropriate precautions to keep yourself and our community healthy.
