KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: December 31, 2020

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has received new COVID-19 case information for the Kodiak Island Borough.

Six (6) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.

- Two (2) new cases were tested on 12/29/20
 - These two (2) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
- Four (4) new cases were tested on 12/30/20
 - Three (3) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
 - One (1) case is travel related

This brings the current case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough to nine hundred and twelve (912); eighty-seven (87) cases are classified as active locally.

To date, there have been a total number of thirty-seven (37) local hospitalizations and five (5) deaths associated with COVID-19; two (2) patients are currently hospitalized in Kodiak.

While we ring in the new year, please continue to be mindful of the people included in your social bubble, limit gatherings to only members of your household if possible, consider small socially-distanced outdoor gatherings, and remember to wear a mask.
