### **KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: April 30, 2021**

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has received new COVID-19 case information for the Kodiak Island Borough.

**Five (5) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.**

- **Five (5) cases were tested on 4/29/21**
  - **One (1) case is travel related**
  - **Three (3) cases are close contacts of a previously reported case**
  - **One (1) case is community spread**

This brings the current case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough to one thousand, one hundred and eighteen (1118); eight (8) cases are classified as active locally; there are no active cases currently hospitalized in Kodiak.

To date, there have been a total number of forty-five (45) local hospitalizations and five (5) deaths associated with COVID-19.

**The COVID-19 virus is highly contagious and is still present in our community; please continue to take appropriate precautions to keep yourself and our community healthy.**

- **Stay home and away from others if you are not feeling well!**
