### **KODIAK, ALASKA, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: July 28, 2021**

The Kodiak Emergency Operations Center has received new COVID-19 case information for the Kodiak Island Borough.

**The COVID-19 virus is highly contagious, and we are experiencing an outbreak of the virus in our community. Please continue to take appropriate precautions to keep yourself and our community healthy.**

**If you are sick or believe you have may have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus, please stay home and away from others.**

**Fourteen (14) new cases have been reported for the Kodiak Island Borough.**

- Thirteen (13) cases were tested on 7/26/21
  - One (1) case is a non-resident travel-related case
  - Ten (10) cases are close contacts of previously reported cases
  - Two (2) cases are considered community transmission
- One (1) case was tested on 7/27/21 and is considered community transmission

This brings the current case count associated with the Kodiak Island Borough to one thousand, two hundred and five (1205); fifty-one (51) cases are classified as active locally.

To date, there have been a total of fifty (50) local hospitalizations and five (5) deaths associated with COVID-19. There are no active cases currently hospitalized in Kodiak.
