## 1. This addendum answer Contractor questions.

- How much fuel is currently in each tank? There are approximately 10 gallons of fuel in each
- 2. Will the owners QEP be doing stockpile characterization sampling or is that part of the contractors' responsibility?

QEP will be doing stockpile characterization sampling

- Who is responsible for applying for an ADEC general construction dewatering permit? The Contractor will be responsible for applying for an ADEC General Construction Dewatering Permit
- 4. Are the tank ballasts required to be removed or can they be abandoned in place? The tank ballasts are required to be removed
- Is there an alternative material we can use to hold down the contaminated cell liner instead of the specified 12" treated poles?
  The City will consider alternate materials to anchor the bottom liner against the dike
- If more than the specified contaminated soil/ water is encountered than the plans call for, is it going to be covered by change order to build storage cell bigger?
  Refer to the City of Kodiak Standard Construction Specification, Division 100, Article 11.03.D
