Kodiak Fire Department evacuates three and extinguishes structure fire.

On Sunday night, January 11, 2015 at approximately 10:01pm the Kodiak Fire Department was dispatched to 1320 East Rezanof Dr for a reported structure fire, flames extending into the trees. The first arriving fire crew reported moderate to heavy flames visible on the roof.

A family of three, including two adults, one child, and one dog were evacuated. The residents had no idea their house was on fire, the initial 911 call was from a neighbor. There were no injuries reported as a result of the fire.

A total of 11 firefighters and 5 units responded. The fire was contained with a majority of the damage to the chimney structure on the roof with minor damage inside the house. The house sustained approximately \$15,000.00 in damages. The Kodiak Fire Department wants to remind the public to check your smoke alarms and replace the batteries twice a year.
