Public Participation Opportunities

Sign up to speak during Public Testimony

At the beginning of the meeting, you may sign up to address the Board during Public Testimony. A sign-up deadline time is posted at the top of the meeting agenda. You will be given 3 minutes to speak.

Submit Written Comments during the Meeting

Throughout the meeting, you may submit to an assigned staff member written comments and other information as a Record Copy (RC). The staff member will distribute your material to each BOF member.

- *Before Board deliberations*, you may submit a maximum of 10-one sided pages or five double-sided pages of written material. You must provide 22 copies to the staff.
- *Once Board deliberations begin*, you may submit a maximum of five one-sided pages. You must provide 22 copies to the staff.
- *If you are NOT at the meeting*, you may FAX one copy of your written material to the staff at 907-465-6094.
