FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Help! I donated something that I wasn't supposed to donate! How do I get it back?

• Email hello@kpla.us with a description of the book(s) and approximately when it was donated/what it was donated with.

I have a lot of books to donate. Do I still take them to Cost Savers?

• If you have more than 5 boxes of books, please email us at hello@kpla.us to coordinate a drop off directly to our storage site! If you have an event coming up (bazaar, book swap) that may have a lot of books left over for donation, please contact us with the details.

I have books that are more valuable than your average used book. How do I make sure it sells for the appropriate amount?

You can still drop the books off at Cost Savers for donation, but please email hello@kpla.us to let us
know what you have dropped off and if you have a value in mind. We try to catch these books with our
normal sorting process, but it is not guaranteed, so any extra information you can provide is helpful!

How do you determine prices for the book sale?

• Prices are based on how many books we have, quality of books, etc, and may change year to year. Books may be priced by the bag, individually, or a combination of both at the discretion of the KPLA Board of Directors.

Can I help with the book collection and sorting process?

• Ok, you might not have been thinking this, but the answer is yes! There will be volunteer opportunities throughout the year to help prepare for the book sale.
