## A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KODIAK NAMING ELECTION WORKERS FOR THE OCTOBER 3, 2023, REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

- Section 7. The City Clerk and Clerk's staff shall have the authority to fill in where needed, and the City Clerk shall have the authority to appoint additional persons, as necessary, to ensure an adequate number of election workers are available to conduct and canvass the election.
