- Projects combined for coordination effort and cost-efficiency.






## Origin of Funding

#### Pier 2 to Downtown Sidewalk Design

- State of Alaska grant \$250,000
  - Identify phased improvements to accommodate cruise ship activity at Port of Kodiak.
  - City of Kodiak believes the most beneficial improvements is for sidewalk between Pier 2 and downtown Kodiak.
- Legislative Appropriation to City of Kodiak \$700,000
  - For design and construction of sidewalk.

#### **Waterfront Planning Design Study**

- City of Kodiak \$100,000
  - To plan for the use and future development of City-owned waterfront property.





### Pier 2 to Downtown Sidewalk Design


### Specific areas of focus will include:
